What is a Vanpool?

A vanpool is a group of from 2 to 15 people who share a vehicle and from 1 to 15 separate passes for the duration of the trip, or more people who share a single pass for the duration of the trip.

VVTA's Program

Vanpools are a primary mass transit mode, and a successful one. Vanpools can save up to 60% a month on a single person's gas and tolls. Gas is paid directly to the vanpool and appears on the driver's statement for payment as a credit. Vanpools are administered by the program and are subject to the same rules and regulations as other transit modes.

Qualification Requirements

- Live in or work in the Victor Valley / Northern High Desert areas
- Have a valid driver's license
- Have a valid driver's license and a valid vehicle registration
- Be a resident of the Victor Valley / Northern High Desert areas; or a resident of the Victor Valley / Northern High Desert areas, Airports and Regional Airport
- Report drivers to the program
- All vanpools must be approved by the program
